Speech & Language Therapy: We have had a visiting therapist Ms Aparna Bhonsle coming 2-3 times a year, for the last 2 years; she has been assessing and giving programmes for 10-12 children which the teachers/therapist were to implement.

This year we had the advantage of 3 young professional for 3 months from UK and they worked with the Roshni students /staff in all projects for Speech and language Assessment and development. They were seeing almost 25 students for Speech & Language and also programming for 3 students with Autism and did some parent and Teachers Training. Ms A Bhonsle was also guiding and supervising their schedules; the input from all The above was very valuable; the teachers and Maya Dubey are continuing the work.

Early Intervention: We have 31 students coming in the ROSHNI EI group since July 2011 ; 7 students joined the Mainstream Schools in Gwalior in the last year the students are- Navya Kukerja, Sachin Kharat, Parth Gadwaikar , Sparsh Jain, Nitya Singh, Ankit Sharma, Khushi Kushwah, Durga Vaishya, all attending schools and coming once a week/month to get support from ROSHNI for therapy and education.

Roshni EI group started new session in April 2011 and made the syllabus for the whole year for centre based group. The infants are now coming twice a week, there are about 10 regular students coming with their parents on Tuesdays /Fridays. The rest come when they can & the children from mainstream school come on Saturdays. EI group students receive Developmental Therapy, Speech therapy and Special Education sessions, through group activity on different themes. Therapy sessions are taken individually as parents come in.

April – Education/ Language/ Hand Function- Water Play and Sand play Done Regularly to increase the children's abilities and concepts- size, shapes and in out; Time concepts, hot/cold concepts by the cup plate game teach by the cup plate game. **Hand function** activities through clay activities and messy play, with rice flour paste and multi sensory activities - smell taste and texture of fruits and vegetables. We also encouraged Hydrotherapy and some children later came for swimming during summer holidays at LNUPE

July –The Rainy Season - every week different topics were covered and ways to explain the Rain and water, use umbrella and coloring pictures. Body image using songs to point to the Facial parts and then review; other body parts tummy, back, hands and legs, hair, using the dolls and children to teach the concepts; puzzles to make body pictures. Many children have difficulty in visual perception. Some children respond fast and some need time to co- operate in a group; mothers and fathers get trained to teach their child.

The Group work from **January to March 2012** was on Wild life project, to teach different animal sounds and pictures by drawing and songs. EI group will plan to visit Zoo for educational tour and picnic.

The visiting physiotherapist from UK & Sp therapist Aparna B, have conducted training for the mothers, in a group on how to develop Language and other motor skills in their children through daily activities and play.

Swami Vivekananda ComDEALL EI Unit for Autism: There was a suggestion by Dr P Karanth, Director the **COMDEALL Trust**, Bangalore to start an Early Intervention Unit for children with Autism. Smt Patankar and Ms Aparna Bhonsle Speech & Language Pathologist, visited the Centre in Bangalore in May 2011 and observed some of the activities and documentation methods.

We started the **ComDEALL Early Intervention Unit for children with Autism Spectrum Disorders -ASD on 13th January 2012, dedicating it to Swamiji Vivekananda, during the week- long Celebration of his 150th Birth Anniversary.** As a result of the Awareness activities with Doctors in October/ November, we have registered three children in December and in February; one outstation child (Raigarh) was included in the Group. There is one Girl with Cerebral Palsy who meets the criteria and could join the Unit once the transport difficulties from their residence are met. The list of 5 children, currently on the list, is attached with this report. 4 children's assessment was done and baseline profile charted in January, prior to the start of the Unit; newcomers are assessed in detail prior to their joining the Programme/Unit. The formal Inauguration is still to take place.

The unit is being conducted as per the plan and guidelines of the ComDEALL Trust provided to the Team during Training in September 2011. The day begins with individual sessions of Education, Occupational therapy and Sensory Integration Therapy according to the needs and requirement of each child. The day begins at 11am and ends at 1.30pm (winter timings). It will start earlier in the summer and once the parents are accustomed to the daily routine.

The 4 regular students with Autism, are given Sensory Integrative Therapy and Activities to enhance Gross Motor and Fine Motor Skills by the RamSevak Developmental therapist, Deepa Lachwani, Occupational therapist/Special Educator Renuka Shrivastava and followed by group activities with music. The mothers are given guidance. So that they can follow the programme at home. A Parents support group is also meeting regularly with these young parents joining the previous group.

Both the EI Grp including the 4 new children in the ComDEALL Unit, also have an animal project and went to the Zoo, for their outing on Autism Day.

Special School:

2nd April 2011 World Autism Awareness Day was celebrated by all students, followed by training for parents, on Communication Methods for Non Verbal children especially with Autism, by visiting consultant Smt Bhuvaneshwari K (Sp Ed Autism) and Ms Shanta Kumar Physiotherapist /Volunteer UK.

All students of all groups were assessed in April and November; reports were given to parents and future goals planned with them.

The new term started on 4th July for students, due to the RCI training.

Cultural & Sports Activities

Annual Day (18th April): Mrs Jagjit Pavadia, Narcotics Commissioner of India, was the chief guest at the function. The calendars made by the Central Bureau of Narcotics, using the painting of our students was presented by her, to all the 11 contributing students, all the staff, volunteers, Roshni committee members and donors. 14 students (7 vocational, 4 Primary, 3 EI), 2 Parents and 1 staff member

(Vivek Sharma) received the annual prizes. A prayer ("Renuka Stuti") was sung by Chetan and Smt Halway, there were Dance items by Primary & Vocational students.

10 students participated in the Special Olympics at LNUPE in April 2011 .

All students and some mothers attended the pooja at Ramakrishna Ashrama Temple at Gurupurnima on 15th July and Ganesh Chaturthi was also celebrated with all the staff of the Ashrama and the children went shopping the next day to buy their Ganesh and celebrated the festival and also Eid .

15th August was celebrated together with the 3 other schools of Ashrama. Smt Jagjit Pavadia, the Narcotics Commissioner of India was chief guest on the 15th August 2011 (Independence Day) and she did the flag hosting .Our 12 older students performed a very impressive PTdisplay; 2 students Santosh Jatav & Ashutosh Mishra & Shri RamSevak(staff) received the Annual Shakuntala Devi Mandhre Scholarships and 11 students were given the remuneration for the Mrignaynee Order for Newspaper & Cloth bags, which they will receive regularly.

On the 21st to 23rd August 2011 Roshni students were invited to attend the Annual day Celebrations at Shehalaya in Gwalior. This year the students were unable to attend the Sports Day and cultural competitions due to the Janamashtami festival and weekend. Mrs. Manjula Patankar attended the inauguration of the Snehalaya International School and the programme.

- **28th August-** On the occasion of The **New Bus Presentation** By **State Bank of India CGM**, 13 Vocational students performed a folk Dance and the primary students did a train action song.

20th August 12 students from vocational went to Bharat Vikas Parishad. The prize winners were:

- Santosh and Seema ,who got hand watches in the Rangoli contest. Seema, Santosh & Ruchika were Runners-up in running, Bocce; Sonali got a prize for Dance and Atul and Yogesh for Drawing. All the remaining students got small tiffin boxes.
- 30 Students participated in Swami Vivekananda Jayanti Sport at Sharda Balgram from 10th to 13 January 2012, during the Vivekanda Jayanti programme. 16 Pre- Vocational and primary 9 Students participated in the rally. 60 students from 5 other NGOs also participated in the **Inclusive Sports Day**.

On 23rd February Shri Ramakrishna Jayanti, 20 students and mothers visited the temple in Ramakrishna Ashrama and participated with the rest of the Ashrama community.

Primary: There are various projects arrange of themes running.

- As part of the communication Religions, Gardening, new places in India & abroad, Rail travel.
- The Grp B had been to the bank under the bank project. Bank Accounts were started too for 5 students at the Central Bank Branch in the Ashrama.
- In the Rail/Train project students learnt about the train tickets, different fares and names of trains Taj express .

- In January 2012 -15 students visited the Gwalior Trade Fair.They have been to various shops and also to Easy Day (Departmental store), with the aim of learning/practising money skills.
- 14 students and 5 mothers visited the zoo on 5th March 2012 and saw the new hippo; they were very excited and enjoyed the trip.
- The EI Grp including the 4 new children in the ComDEALL Unit, also have an animal project and will be going to the Zoo, for their outing.
- **Pre-Vocational:** The students were taken shopping regularly for educational visits to learn about money.
- The students were taken out for a visit to learn the **road making concepts** including divider,traffic rules –the use of speed breakers, zebra crossing, traffic signals was also taught.

Projects done: In April The project was about freedom fighters, leaders, from different countries through maps. The educational trip to Bhopal in March was revised and the places of interest visited told to the rest of the class.

Vocational: The 10 students in the **Madhya Pradesh Hastshilp & Hast Kargha Vikas Nigam-** MPHHVN training worked throughout the summer vacation with support from 5-6 mothers, who came in, to do duties very regularly & are still training in Jewellery making & Embroidery from March till September; they are receiving a stipend of ` 500/- pm. They are also earning through the regular **Mrignaynee** order of news paper bags and cloth bags.

Vocational group also managed stalls at various places for the **Rakhi sales**; this provided the group with the opportunity to sell their products to an increased number of customers.

They have also started a **service for NRIs**, to post **Rakhi's** to their relatives in India & Students are writing the greeting cards. We need to advertise and extend this service beyond Singapore. The sales were less than last year due to closures and bandhs.

Training: RCI Bhoj-University Foundation Course for teachers: A **Foundation Course** of 90 days duration for mainstream teachers as approved and recognized by Rehabilitation Council of India and Madhya Pradesh Bhoj Open University was conducted by Roshni Ramakrishna Ashrama, Gwalior, commencing in the first week of June 2011; Roshni was appointed as a study center No. 1722. The first phase of training, June to August was attended by 52 teachers from Government schools from 13 teachers

Sheopur and 24 Guna districts and local NGOs including 4 mothers, was held in 2 batches from 06 to 19 June and 21 June to 4 July 2011. There was a week's practical training from 1st to 7th August & 16th to 22nd August for the two batches respectively followed by a written the examination was on 31st August and the rest will be conducted by distance mode in their own place of work. We had the support of Dr B Shukla and other Resource persons mainly Drs and professionals from Gwalior, including Roshni Staff and 3 from Delhi. The examination Was conducted on 31st August 2011 by Shri RP Singh, Principal of Govt, Mook Badhir Vidyalaya Gwalior, external examiner and Smt Manjula Patankar was the internal Examiner, Smt Rakhi Asthana, Smt Deepa Lachhwani, Shri Ramsevak Invigilated The result of the Sheopur / Guna Batch is received by us, all 51 candidates have passed with first division except 1 who did not come for the external examination. We found their response and attitudinal change encouraging. The second batch October – December 2011 had more entrants from Government Schools from Ashoknagar 26 and Datia 30, 14 private

candidates from different NGOs & 10 private candidates from different NGOs including 2 mothers, in the 2nd batch and they completed the 15 day training on Oct /November 2011 The Internal Examination (Viva) was conducted for the two batches for which Shri RP Singh, Principal of Govt, Mook Badhir Vidyalaya Gwalior was external examiner and Smt Manjula Patankar. The final Examination of the Bhoj University was conducted on 31st December 2011.

Smt Rakhi and Smt Manjula attended the National Knowledge workshop, AGM & LLC Meetings on 9/10/11 September respectively and Smt Renuka attended the Arunim AGM on 18 September.

LLC Meeting Bhind: Held on 14 July 2011 Smt Manjula Patankar and Smt Rakhi Asthana attended the meeting with the Distt Collector, they also met the Shri Ashok Shivhare, Commissioner Chambal . Division and attended a meeting of all the Block Development Officers to explain the National Trust schemes during the Government Camps that have been planned for the next 2 months to follow—the topics were:

..A Training was held on 17 th May for Medical Practitioners at the GR Medical college by Full From pthe and Shri RK Soni, the new Jt Director took the initiative to sensitize Govt Doctors of the medical Board. Shri RK Soni also was invited to inaugurate the RCI Training and lectured on Govt Schemes in June.

LLC Meeting Gwalior: There has been no LLC meeting since July 2010 at Gwalior; Shri P Narhari, the new Collector held an LLC meeting following the district Ceo/Block Level meeting, at the New Collectorate on 16th January 2012. 14 Guardianship papers were submitted were approved. Medical Camps were held at 8 Ngos from 11-24 January. Roshni camp was organised on 24 Jan and was attend by 81 beneficiaries, 35 Sparsh Pension Applications were received

Fund Raising:

-Presentation of New Bus: The presentation ceremony of the special bus was held on 28 July 2011 at Roshni Ramakrishna Ashrama. The Chief Guests for the ceremony were **Shri M Bhagvantha Rao Deputy Managing Director of the State Bank of India & his wife Smt Bhanumati Rao.** Shri Vijay Rangnekar AGM PR &Corporate Social Banking Bhopal, Shri S Ganeshan Regional Manager and other members, to gether with members of SBI Ladies Club were also present.

After the traditional lamp lighting Swamiji gave his blessings and thanked Shri Bhagvantha .Rao for this special bus which will facilitate the conveyance of persons with severe multiple disabilities in comfort and safety. Smt Manjula Patankar gave the brief on the progress of the last 13 years; She gave the Vision of Roshni to create an environment in which persons with disabilities and their families are supported and fully accepted with equal rights into society.

She mentioned the various services provided at Roshni and our special focus on Early Intervention (1 to 6 years) to ensure Inclusive Education in conventional School , the older students who need Vocational Training and Job Opportunities & Employment for their future; and mentioned the importance of the National Trust and its schemes specially the Niramaya Health Insurance, Gyan Prabha, Udhayam Prabha and the Guardianship. She requested the Dep. MD to support us at a higher level regarding the problem parents are facing in opening accounts for their children despite the RBI directives. All banks in small towns need to be aware that every child with disability is to have a joint account with his guardian, so that the cheques paid to them, under different schemes, can be directly remitted to their accounts. She also spoke of difficulties in **ACCESS** to banks and ATMs by people in wheel chairs and senior citizens.

The primary children entertained with a train action song and older students performed a colourful folk dance. We had a big gathering of our supporters and donors despite the short notice. Swami Swarupanand blessed the bus and Shri & Smt M Bhagvantha Rao flagged it off with Jagdish and Shailendra in their wheel chairs and others in the seats.

There was a visit by **Smt V Radharani Rao** w/o the new GM SBI Bhopal and members of the Ladies club of the State Bank of India to Roshni. They donated 2 adult Wheelchairs and a toilet chair on 19th October 2011. They promised to support in different ways in the future too as volunteers.

-In mid September there was an inspection visit from a 2-member team from **Sir Ratan Tata Trust** for approval for Roshni to start a ComDEALL Unit for Early detection & Intervention for infants 2-6 years with Autism and some Cerebral Palsy children with Speech and Communication problems. Subsequent to their approval 3 ROSHNI staff - Ram Sevak, Leader, Deepa Lachhwani OT and Renuka Shrivastava, (Sp Ed) attended a 10 days training on Early Intervention for Autism, by The ComDEALL Trust in Bangalore from 19 to 29 September 2011. We have applied to them for funding for this Unit now from the Small Grants Scheme of NRTT which is underway and is being followed up now .

-The **Airtel Delhi Half Marathon 2011** took place on Sunday the 27th of November. We registered Roshni Ramakrishna Ashrama again this year with **Concern India Foundation to Run for A Cause**. This year TEAM ROSHNI had 2 Students participating in the wheelchair category Mritunjaya with his father Dr Singhal, Neel with Renuka Shrivastava as escort; Manjula Patankar in the Senior Citizen Category(4kms) 2 volunteers Charlotte Carter and Zoe Crook were in the 6 kms Great Delhi Run.

This year we ran to raise funds towards the **completion of Phase II of the Roshni Swarna Jayanti Building**. We have raised approximately Rs 2 Lacs including the FoR Volunteers collection in the UK. Last year we raised over Rs 1 Lac towards the balance payment for a Special Bus with Ramp- for our Special students.

We hope to raise this amount so as to start the construction for the Training Centre and the Vocational Unit at ROSHNI which need to expand. There is an urgent need to complete the 1st floor of our building, to ensure adequate space for the new activities we have undertaken, the regular 90-day RCI Foundation Course for Mainstream Teachers and with an ever increasing number of young adults coming to ROSHNI the expansion of the vocational project and visitors rooms, are an urgent need. We are soon initiating an Early Intervention Unit for children with Autism/ASD which will be a daily Programme for 1-6 year olds, so the Ground floor will be fully utilised.
